What is happening?

Flooding is no longer expected in the Tweed, Rouse, Brunswick River catchments and Marshalls Creek, and the Richmond, Orara, Bellinger and Kalang River catchments

FLOODING CONTINUES ALONG THE WILSONS RIVER

A coastal trough is located near the north coast, with an embedded low-pressure system likely to develop off the Mid North Coast and move further offshore tomorrow. Showers are expected over the ranges and NSW coast, with a chance of thunderstorms.

The Bureau of Meteorology is continuing to monitor the situation and will issue further catchment specific warnings if and when required.

What we are expecting:

Flooding is no longer expected in the following catchments.

Tweed and Rouse Rivers
Brunswick River and Marshalls Creek
Richmond River
Orara River
Bellinger and Kalang Rivers
