### **Tweed River at Tumbulgum**

Issued: Friday 23 September 2022 at 1:15am



#### What is happening?

Minor flooding is forecast for the Tweed River, impacting on the town of Murwillumbah and Tweed Heads also the towns of Condong, Tumbulgum, Chinderah, Bilambil, Fingal, Kingscliff, Seagulls Estate, Banora Point, Uki, Tayalgah and Chillingham.

MINOR FLOODING POSSIBLE AT TUMBULGUM FRIDAY MORNING

Very heavy rainfall across the Tweed River catchment has caused significant river level rises along the Tweed River and its Tributaries, which has the potential to cause minor flooding along the Tweed River at Tumbulgum from Friday morning.

#### What we are expecting:

Minor flooding may occur along the Tweed River at Tumbulgum.

The Tweed River at Murwillumbah may reach the minor flood level (3.00 m) around 10:00 am Friday. Further rises are possible.

 Low lying farm land may be affected, farmers are advised to monitor equipment and livestock.

#### At Tumbulgum: (Local Gauge information is also tidal)

Dulguigan Road may close opposite the Tumbulgum village.

#### What you need to do:

Low lying parts of Murwillumbah and surrounding communities are likely to be impacted by flooding. People in these areas should prepare for potential isolation and possible evacuation.

People in areas likely to be impacted by flooding should consider:

- Refraining from driving or walking through flood water
- Road closures and flood isolation may impact on work, family and educational commitments
- Monitoring emergency warnings and severe weather updates on local ABC radio, <u>NSW SES</u> <u>Northern Rivers Facebook Page</u> and Bureau of Meteorology website
- If your property is at risk of inundation, please raise moveable items, such as furniture, as high as possible onto benches or tables, placing electrical items on top
- If you are advised by an emergency services officer to evacuate, please do so
- Securing outside belongings and before leaving; turn off the power, water and take essential medicines and clothes with you
- Farmers should move machinery, livestock, pumps and fodder to flood free ground
